SATURDAY MORNING CLASSES

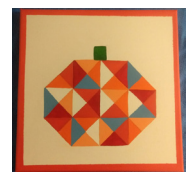
Did you know that we have Saturday morning classes this fall? These non-recital classes will meet four times: October 12, November 9, January 11 and February 8.
