SATURDAY MORNING CLASSES

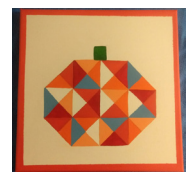
Did you know that we have Saturday morning classes this fall? These non-recital classes will meet four times: October 12, November 9, January 11 and February 8.

9:30 - Right after the mother/child jazz class, we will have an Art Class. There will be four different projects! The last time this artist was at our studio, they did a beautiful ballerina canvas painting! There is a discount if you sign up for both the jazz class and this class.
